Working together for Atlanta through stronger coordination and cooperation

- ▶ Support Atlanta Public Schools as a viable option for families of school aged children
- ▶ Release the deeds to APS properties
- ▶ Continue the coterminous growth of city and district boundaries
- ▶ Coordinate on legislative strategies, financial decisions and emergency responses
- ▶ Uphold current Tax Allocation District agreements
- ▶ Streamline the construction/renovation permitting process
- ▶ Partner with Atlanta Public Schools to prevent reductions in public funding to schools

Building safe routes and communities

- ▶ Ensure closer collaboration between APD and APSPD to improve neighborhood safety
- Build sidewalks in all school zones and provide street crossing aids in all high traffic areas
- ▶ Tear down or repurpose abandoned buildings located near APS schools

Investing in the future and increasing opportunities

- Launch and fund a joint initiative to guarantee quality early childhood education for every child in Atlanta
- Lower APS' mobility rate by developing a comprehensive affordable housing strategy
- Commit to collaborative procurement processes to strengthen inclusive practices for minority- and women-owned enterprises
- ▶ Develop paid internship programs for APS high school students
- ► Endow the City's Cultural Arts Program for APS students
